Teams of volunteers call their clients each week to connect and take their grocery orders from home or work.



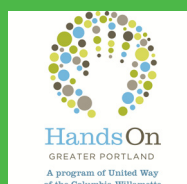
#### We Shop

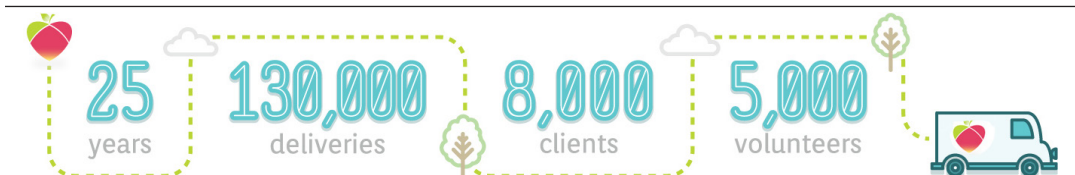

# 2014 Program Outcomes

We are delighted to share the amazing outcomes our program produced with your support:



- Store to Door served 460 seniors and people with disabilities, completing 7,012 deliveries of fresh food, prescription medications, and personal care items. This represents a 13.5% increase in clients served compared to 2013.
- 99% of clients surveyed said that our service helps them maintain independence and 95% said they felt more socially supported after enrolling.

- Advocacy calls or referrals for additional supportive or protective services were made on behalf of 100% of clients assessed as at-risk.
- We engaged 587 volunteers who gave 12,246 hours of service and direct client assistance by taking orders, shopping, and

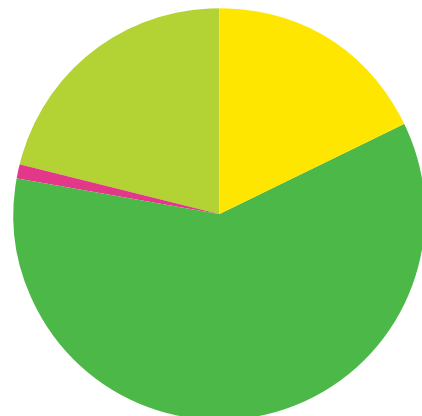
- making deliveries. This represents a 32% increase in volunteer hours.
- 95% of our volunteers said they learned more about a community need and 97% felt they were taking action to meet that need.

## 2014 Financial Snapshot

Did you know that while clients pay an average delivery fee of just \$3-6 per order, it actually costs Store to Door about \$40 to fill and deliver each order? Last year, over \$300,000 in contributions made up the difference.

- 60% Foundations
- 1% Government Grants
- 21% Individual Donations
