Client Profile: Ann Plasker

Ann is a self-described "plant-a-holic" who loves the Portland area. Before she retired, Ann held many jobs, ranging from word processing to occupational therapy, managing a Chamber of Commerce for

a town in Arizona, working in inside sales for an electrical supply agency, bartending, even driving an 18-wheeler truck. "I learned something from every one of the jobs that I wouldn't have learned any other

way," she said.

Ann, 76, stopped driving due to eye problems and side effects of multiple sclerosis, and now uses a walker to get around. She says, "With Store to Door, it doesn't make me feel dependent on other people. It has helped me immensely."

Ann says, "Everyone is so kind at Store to Door. Of the agencies I've worked with, Store to Door is one of the best."



A Story of Connection

It's impossible not to be inspired by the impact Bob Lustberg has made on Store to Door. "For twenty years," he says, "I called for orders, I shopped, and delivered orders, and I had the time of my life."

Bob also recruited long-time volunteers, such as Jean Pierce, a volunteer for over twenty years and a current Store to Door board member. He recruited fellow Washington Park Host Ann Dalton, a volunteer shopper for over 12 years who

is now a Store to Door client. "Bob is indefatigable," Ann says, recollecting how he volunteered in so many roles for Store to Door, "he is so positive and
