Volunteer Position Description

Volunteer Role: Friday Food Box Delivery Volunteer

Goal/Purpose: To provide a free food box to low-income clients on one Friday per month.

Reports To: Trish Bennett, Program Coordinator

- Arrive to the Sunshine Division, 687 N Thompson St, Portland, OR 97227
 - Park nearby, walk around the side of the building to the big garage doors
- Help assemble your food boxes (about 5 per volunteer)
- Load your personal vehicle with the food boxes, careful not to crush any food
- Use the routing sheet with names, addresses, and contact information to locate each client's residence
- Identify yourself as a Store to Door volunteer, delivering their free food box
- Provide client with their food box, help unload the food, and enjoy a short visit
- Maintain client confidentiality
- Communicate periodically with supervisor; report incidents, concerns or updates

Requirements:

- Must be 18 years of age or older
- Reliable transportation and proof of auto liability
- Valid Driver's License and clean driving record
- Must pass a background check
- Sensitivity to homebound seniors and adults with disabilities

Physical Demands:

- Able to carry multiple 30-35 pound boxes

Benefits:

- Engage with seniors and adults with disabilities; build inter-generational relationships
- Reimbursement of \$.50 per mile
