Rose Court Princesses to Volunteer Grocery Shop for Local Seniors

- WHAT** Fifteen members of the [Rose Festival Court](#) will volunteer with [Store to Door](#) this week, supporting local home-bound seniors and people with disabilities.
- WHO** With the help of hundreds of volunteers, donors, and community partners, Store to Door supports independent living for Portland area seniors and people with disabilities. The Rose Court will be joining Store to Door to grocery shop for those who otherwise would have difficulty getting food, medications and other household necessities.
- WHY** Store to Door's award-winning, volunteer-based grocery shopping and delivery service has served over 8,000 clients and made more than 130,000 grocery deliveries in the last quarter century. It is the only service of its kind in Oregon and demand is sharply on the rise. By volunteering, the members of the Rose Festival Court will be helping Store to Door achieve its vision: for all elders and people with disabilities in the community to be nourished, cared for, and able to age-in-place in the setting of their choice.
