- WHAT** OnPoint Community Credit Union will sponsor grocery delivery costs for approximately 70 local seniors and people with disabilities on September 17, 2014 through Store to Door's new **Support-A-Day** program. Eight OnPoint employees will celebrate the day by grocery shopping for Store to Door clients, along with 14 other volunteers from the Portland area.
