U.S. Bank Sponsors Over 85 Grocery Deliveries for Homebound Seniors on 11/18

WHAT

U.S. Bank will sponsor grocery delivery costs for approximately 85 local seniors and people with disabilities on November 18, 2015 through Store to Door's **Support-A-Day** program. Ten U.S. Bank employees will celebrate the day by grocery shopping for Store to Door clients, along with 15 additional volunteers from the Portland area.
